### Description of content

Achieving high value for patients must become the overarching goal of health care delivery. Value is defined as the result of outcome of care undertaken over its cost and should be considered over the full cycle of care of a disease. It is not merely the result of a single treatment, or an intervention, or examination. It actually entails the result of the actions undertaken by all health care professionals working around the condition, e.g. with psoriasis: the dermatologist, but also the rheumatologist, the GP, the nurse, the psychologist, the pharmacologist, the patient advocacy group, etc.

In this symposium, leaders in psoriasis will bring their thoughts on how to look at the patient beyond disease, on strong tools to unravel unmet needs, and on how to evaluate treatment results in an innovative way. The Janssen Chair in 'Value in Psoriasis' will be inaugurated at the occasion of this event.

The symposium is open to all healthcare professionals and researchers active in the field of chronic immune diseases, as psoriasis is - as a hallmark chronic systemic disease - a model to many other chronic diseases.
